This week read ACTS 19:3-20:38



REFLECTION: Once again Paul finds himself angering locals because he is a threat to their finances. The silversmiths and craftsmen in Ephesus created a riot in response to the message of Paul, gathering people together, most of whom “had no idea why they had come together.” The town clerk finally came in as a voice of reason on behalf of the disciples.

- Do you give in to the thinking and chaos of the crowd as you try and live your faith? How?
- Have you stood up as the voice of reason during times of anger or peer pressure on behalf of the Good News? How?
- Are you a part of a community that easily becomes chaotic or angry?
- How do you contribute to or challenge those experiences?

*How do my reflections today inform how I will live out my discipleship in the world this week?*

Could I...

- Sit with someone new at lunch who doesn't have a friend?
- Reach out to someone in my residence hall who has a “bad reputation”?
- Confront the office gossip about his or her behavior?

How else could I act it out?



**What is CROP Walk?**

**CROP** stands for **C**ommunities **R**esponding to **O**vercome **P**overty. This will be the 41st anniversary for CROP Walk. It is a 5-mile walk taking place on May 2 – starting and ending at Waring Baptist Church – to alleviate hunger. The walk begins at 1:30 pm.

—75% of the money raised goes towards hunger relief and economic development in the U.S. and around the world.

—25% stays right here in the Rochester area. Local agencies benefiting from this walk: Community Food Cupboard, Irondequoit Food Cupboard, Food Pantry at the Waring Baptist Church, Food Cupboard at St. Andrews Church.

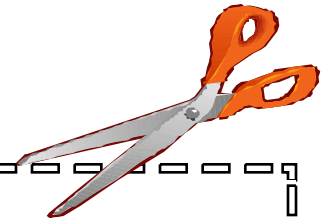


**PO DC ASTS**

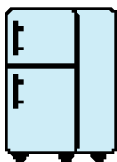
**NOMINATION BALLOT FOR 2010-2011 PASTORAL COUNCIL**
